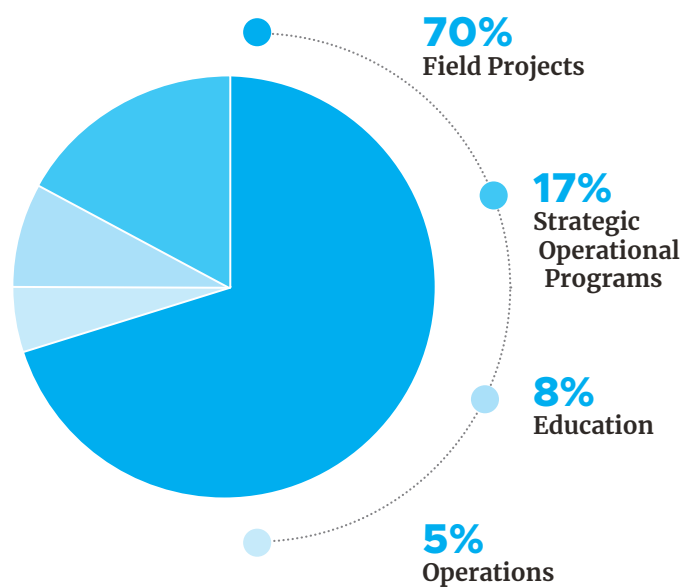

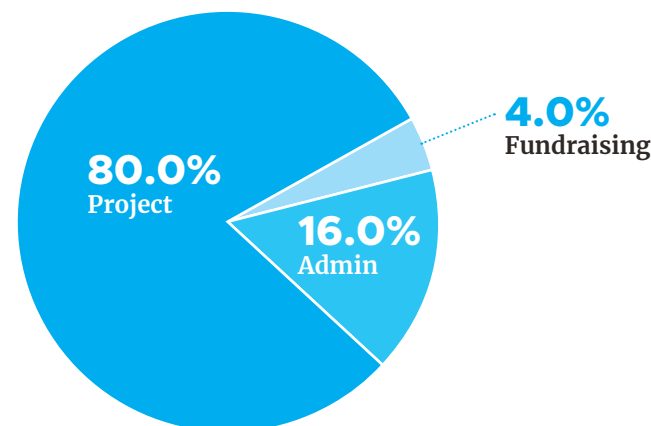

## How we serve

Through relief and relationship, The Joshua Fund participates in what God is doing in the Middle East by primarily partnering with faithful, fruitful, local congregations, whose ministry blesses Israel and Her Neighbors in the name of Jesus. This is accomplished through **four main areas of impact**:



**SERVE**  
Serving the needy and mitigating the problem of hunger in Israel and Her Neighbors.



**ENCOURAGE**  
Encouraging pastors and investing in healthy church communities in the Epicenter.



**EQUIP**  
Equipping the global church to learn, pray, give, and go, and mobilizing God's loving plan in the Epicenter.



**TEACH**  
Teaching the Word of God through highly-vetted local organizations in the Middle East.

**135+** churches, ministry leaders, evangelists and missionaries supported in the Epicenter.

**6** women in the Middle East region received trauma counseling training to help hurting women and children in their communities.

**290** Arabic audio Bibles distributed in regions hostile to the Gospel.

**50+** single moms and families in need have received free legal aid in the Old City of Jerusalem.

**95** Muslims have come to faith in Jesus through ministry partners in the Arab world.

**1,600+** needy children received new backpacks & school supplies.

**245** attended gatherings for women who have come out of a Muslim background, suffered abuse, or have fled from war or other threats.

**35+** moms and their newborns living in poverty given financial support and counseling.

**905** young adults connected to an Arab Christian church.

**100+** families devastated by earthquakes in Syria received critical aid immediately following the disaster.

**21** humanitarian aid Distribution Centers actively operating throughout Israel in partnership with local congregations.

**7,980+** people in poverty were blessed with food packs each month.

**60+** new believers equipped through a leadership training program.

**10** Arabic speaking women in Jerusalem received free Hebrew lessons to increase job opportunities and escape poverty.

**97%** of key Jewish and Arab ministry leaders in Israel attended a Joshua Fund Bible conference and retreat.
