atima* and her family used to live in constant fear for their lives. ISIS had taken control of their capital during the war, and no place was safe. So they were always on the move, escaping from one place to the next.

Eventually, they found refuge in a neighboring country, but that was just the beginning of their freedom. Through a Joshua Fund-supported ministry, they encountered Christ for the first time, and life would never be the same. This is Fatima's story:

"One day, I was surprised to see a crowd at the gate of a church. I was told people go there to worship. Something was intriguing. I wanted to know what church and worship meant, so I decided to go inside.

I sat in the back with my three kids, clueless as to what was going on. But I was drawn to the worship music like a magnet. Words like "prayer" and the "Lord Jesus" were new to me. Every Sunday, I moved one row forward, and I never stopped asking questions. I asked, 'Who is God? Who is the Lord Jesus? Tell me about this God of peace and love.' Something inside of me changed, and I decided to give my life to Him. It was the best day of my life.

Fatima shared the Good News of Christ with her husband and children—all of them becoming believers. And although the rest of her family rejected her and her newfound faith, Fatima remains determined to keep sharing about the Lord to others.

Your support helped us do things like relocate people during times of war, provide humanitarian aid to those affected by the tragic conflict between Israel & Gaza, and provide other types of critical or lifesaving Rapid Response in the Epicenter.

This is a top priority for The Joshua Fund as we seek to serve and assist churches that are faithfully preaching and teaching, making disciples, and caring for the needy. And we couldn't do it without you.

n a region where rockets have recently flown indiscriminately towards homes in southern Israel, ministers in the desert, Danny* and Samira* have seen many unique dwellings.

None have compared to Ahmed's family home.

Ahmed* grew up in a small cave carved in the side of an arid mountain south of Jerusalem. While he and his siblings do not live in their childhood home, they use it as a shared space with a nearby 500-gallon water tank and stored refrigerator.

Their "tribe" of five families currently lives in tiny shacks with no connection to either water or electricity. They must pay to have their communal water tank filled regularly, but it is costly.

Work is scarce, and pay is low when any work is acquired where Ahmed's family lives. Their citizenship classification makes them ineligible to work in Israel, making it challenging to earn a living and pay for basic living expenses.

Ahmed's "tribe" of Palestinian families is exceedingly grateful for the nourishing food packages they have received through the help of donors like you.

Because of your generous gifts, these siblings and their families experience the love of Christ and relief from a tremendous burden, and we can help fund other critical programs.

Please keep Ahmed's "tribe" in prayer, along with the many other families around them who are struggling to provide necessities. You are the hands and feet of Christ who share with those who need it the most. The Joshua Fund is grateful to have you as a partner in our ministry.

bomb landed on Amir's*
home in Syria; his family
lost everything in 2012.
Desperate for safety, they
fled to Lebanon. Amir began writing
poems of pain describing his family's
anger, sadness, and homesickness. He
focused on doing well in school to one
day help his family out of their present
poverty.

Amir was open-minded and willing to talk about the contradictions he found in his Islamic faith. While walking through a common market, he found an old, partially damaged Bible on the ground and felt led to purchase it.

As Amir read the Scriptures, there was a sense of peace and love found in the teachings. Shortly following, he met a ministry supported by The Joshua Fund and started attending their worship gatherings. Later, he told the staff that he felt conflicted; he was resisting God's call and felt relieved in hearing the messages preached from the Bible.

Soon after, Amir's father became ill and could no longer provide for his family's needs. The loss of income meant Amir would have to stop his education and find employment and forfeit the pursuit of his dreams for the future. This slipping dream broke his heart, and for the first time, Amir prayed to Jesus to heal his father.

And Jesus did.

When his father's health improved and he could go back to work, Amir was so affected by this answered prayer that he began praying to Jesus more often and reading the Bible more fervently. His heart was filled with Jesus's love and peace.

Now he volunteers with our ministry partner to help others find Jesus. For the first time, he is looking forward to the future because he knows that God has a plan for his life.


