Not knowing if she'll ever see her home again, and struggling with her harsh new reality as a refugee, Aria* had little hope for the future.

Aria and her family became refugees after a war devastated their homeland. Though they had escaped physical harm, their mental, emotional, and spiritual battles were far from over.

She received a lifeline when a friend told her about a Bible study run by a Joshua Fundsupported ministry partner.

I fell in love with the Bible study and waited eagerly for church every Sunday," Aria said. "We had lots of burdens, problems, and worries, but these were the times when we would let go of them.

The Bible study gives hope to Aria and others like her and allows them to build a strong foundation for their new life as they hear the Word of God and learn Biblical principles.

During those meetings, we shared all our problems and learned how to apply the Bible to our lives, our kids, our relatives, our neighbors.

Most importantly, the Bible study shares the Gospel. It is often the first time many refugees have even heard about Jesus.



It was so new to us because, in the past, we had never heard of all this overwhelming love and peace. Our homes felt so peaceful, and we felt that we weren't forsaken.

Through your generosity, hope reaches Aria and other refugees. They, in turn, become ambassadors among their people, spreading the love of Christ to others who are displaced and desperate.

With thousands of internally displaced people in the region, this Joshua Fund ministry partner is sowing seeds that will reap a plentiful harvest as people like Aria and her family tell those around them of the hope they have found in Jesus.

Eliana's* mother survived the Holocaust, but she and her neighbors now faced a new threat - Hunger.

When her mom fell ill, Eliana moved in to take care of her. Living in a government-subsidized housing complex for Holocaust survivors, Eliana witnessed her new, elderly community struggle with hunger amid a deadly pandemic.

A local congregation supported by The Joshua Fund became a lifeline for these Holocaust survivors, reaching out and providing the food they so desperately needed.

The congregation's kindness and compassion touched Eliana. Through their selfless giving, she discovered Christ's love and has never been the same.

Eliana now has a new purpose: to show compassion and love in practical ways. Even after her mother's passing, Eliana continues to live in the same place to look after her neighbors and serve as a faithful volunteer with the food distribution at the complex.

Because of you, Eliana and other volunteers can continue to provide critical resources directly to the least of these in their communities.



The vision of Eliana's church is to reach out to their community in the Lord's love. Through the food distribution ministry, made possible by The Joshua Fund and its supporters, they are doing just that.

A primary educational goal of The Joshua Fund is to help the Church connect the dots from global events to Scripture, and educate and mobilize Christians to "bless Israel and Her Neighbors in the name of Jesus" (Gen. 12:1-3).

These and other related topics define our podcast "Inside The Epicenter." The podcast has 3M+ views and downloads, and is in the top 2% of podcasts worldwide.

Unprecedented opportunities unfold rapidly.

I've taken seven delegations of Evangelical leaders to Israel and the Arab world—historical opportunities. We spent time with local pastors and ministry leaders, and met with kings, crown princes, presidents, and prime ministers.

All Israel News and All Arab News are cutting-edge educational platforms covering Israel and the Arab Muslim world through a Biblical lens. We advance these two websites, published in Jerusalem daily, with venture capital investments.



Also, I've launched a primetime show from Israel on TBN, the world's most-watched Christian television network, called 'The Rosenberg Report,' examining key leaders and events in the Epicenter.



2022 Program Expense Allocations


